Pázmány Péter Catholic University, Budapest, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Doctoral School of History invites to submit proposals for an international conference that aims to reflect upon reconstruction as form, theory or method. The Doctoral School has been organizing conferences for many years in topics of art history and monument protection. The present conference which we enter on international scene with, carries on tradition. The key focus of the (Re)Construction Conference are on analysis of protection, restoration, theoretical or/and practical reconstruction of any field of cultural heritage.

Working Language

The official language of the conference is English, but it is possible to present a paper in another language, if presenters provide a written English translation.

Programme

The (Re)Constructions Conference will be held online via Zoom on 4 March, 2021 (Thursday). Prior registration is required. During the day participants will give presentations on the topics set above in several consecutive sections. The length of the presentations will be 20 minutes, followed by a 5-minute discussion period.

Call for papers in (Re)Construction Conference digital proceedings is open till 15 January, 2021. We require the abstracts in max 2000 characters without spacing. Please submit your proposal accompanied by short biographies to the Organizing Committee. Response will be given till end of January. Presentations of the conference will not be published.
