There may be an opportunity to publish papers presented at the conference with Fairleigh Dickinson University Press.

Traditional presentations are 20 minutes plus time for questions. Undergrads are invited to propose 10-minute presentations for a limited number of slots. Other formats are possible: if you'd like to propose a roundtable, workshop, collaboration, masterclass, performance, etc., write up what you have in mind!
